An in-house and in-field training program on Rocky Gas Co-op's procedures and using specialized equipment will be provided. Ideal candidates should relish the thought of walking.

Responsibilities:

- Walking along our natural gas pipelines, entering yards up to the gas meter.
- · Walking in rural areas occasionally through rough terrain including creeks, wooded areas, various field types and weather
- · Conduct our own utility locations as required.
- Conduct or analyze data regarding line locations, construction prints, and leak detection.
- Operate various electronic devices including use of a receiver and transmitter designed to assist in the locating and verifying of underground utilities, and leak detection.
- · Prepares various reports and documentation verifying marked utilities using software on a laptop or iPad.
- · Complete locates to Rocky Gas Co-op Ltd. standards and schedules as required.

Utility Construction Labourer

Position Summary: The position is responsible for participating in daily tasks to complete work with underground natural gas pipeline construction and installation. The ideal candidate should also be familiar with directional drilling, hydro-vac, excavation and trenching.

- Operate equipment such as 1 ton reel truck, skid steer, mini hoe.
- Complete line locates as required.
